WHEREAS: The January 22, 1991 agenda of the Cambridge License Commission has among items to be discussed and voted upon a proposed regulation requiring "any licensee who desires to store extra chairs on the licensed premises" to secure the approval of the License Commission prior to storing said chairs; and

WHEREAS: Prior to any vote on this regulation, the business community should have sufficient input into the regulatory process so that they understand the rationale behind such a proposal and whether or not any additional fees or special requirements would be placed on existing and/or future licenses; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to obtain a written policy statement from the License Commission which outlines the reasons and potential impact of this proposed regulation and further submit said response to the City Council for its review; said report should be submitted prior to the adoption of this regulation.
