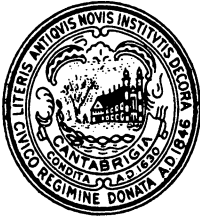

Repairs to City Streets

Please be advised the Public Works Department has \$100,000 appropriated in its budget commencing with the Fiscal Year July 1978, for the resurfacing of City streets. This \$100,000 is Block Grant Funding, which will resurface approximately four average streets and five blocks in length.

It is also hoped that this coming year, additional EDA Funds may be available, and an application will be submitted if these funds are forthcoming. The construction and repairs in the streets which have been excavated for sewer construction will be resurfaced by the sewer contractors under the particular contract they have with the City. The funds for these street resurfacing is included in the sewer construction grants.

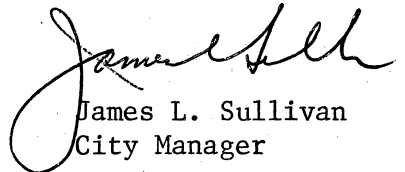
