Resolved;-

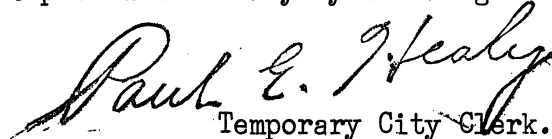
This City Council joins with his family and friends in sorrow over his loss and extends its sympathy and hope for comfort to those who were near him; and be it further resolved
