

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, Apr 20. 1887

Ordered,

That permission be granted to Colin Chisholm, to construct a bulk head upon the sidewalk in front of the buildings he is now erecting on Cambridge Street, southerly side, on the corner of Tremont Street, also to place curbing in said sidewalk around three basement windows in said buildings, and to place a manhole in the sidewalk in front of said buildings.

Provided, that the hinges shall be placed upon ^{doors} ~~the doors~~ of said bulkhead, so that said ^{doors} shall constitute a guard to protect the passers-by from liability to danger, when said doors are open. The ^{authorized} entire work to be done under this order, to be under the direction and to the satisfaction of the City Engineer.
