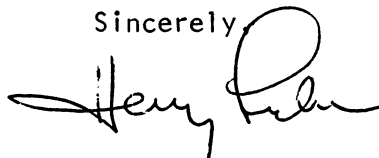
My wife and I wish to express to all of you our sincere appreciation for all the support you showed toward the residents in the Porter Square area regarding the proposed construction at the Sears site.
