WHEREAS: The Chairs of the General Court's Joint Committee on Public Safety recently announced the filing of **"An Act Providing for the Construction and Rehabilitation of Police and Fire Stations in the Commonwealth:"** and

WHEREAS: The parameters of this bill would work similar to the School Building Assistance Act; and

WHEREAS: This Bill would provide for grants of between 60 and 75 percent of the costs of individual police and fire station construction and up to 90 percent for joint fire and police facilities; and

WHEREAS: There is a portion of the bill that would allow for reimbursement for construction that began on such facilities after January 1, 1994; and

WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge has recently began renovation of such facilities and the Cambridge Police Station is in needed of much work to bring the facilities into the 21st Century; and

WHEREAS: It is likely that said bill will be acted on in the 1996 session; and

WHEREAS: The Committee Chairs encouraged communities likely to apply for a construction grant for police or fire station to contact their legislators as soon as possible; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager is hereby requested to confer with our Legislative Delegation as to our support of "**An Act Providing for the Construction and Rehabilitation of Police and Fire Stations in the Commonwealth;**" and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager is hereby requested to ensure that we are ready to provide for said state assistance for the construction and/or rehabilitation of our Police Station and Fire Stations to bring them into the 21st century.
