Comments, objections and requests for a public hearing on the proposed service must be made in writing with specific reasons for requesting a public hearing, and filed with the Secretary of the Department on or before April 22, 1994.

The petitioner, Amtel Communications Payphones, Inc., is required to give notice by publication hereof once, [on or before April 1, 1994], which is twenty-one (21) days prior to April 22, 1994, in the Boston Globe, the Morning Union (Springfield), the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield), and the Worcester Telegram; and to make return of service and publication no later than April 29, 1994.
