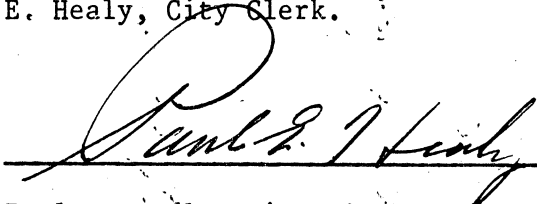
COUNCILLOR DUEHAY

- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge will be the recipient of a \$3.6 million increase in the amount of money available from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts for FY84-85, which amount was the fourth largest increase given to any City in the Commonwealth; and
- WHEREAS: This increase will result in the City of Cambridge receiving from the Commonwealth the total amount of \$27,135,540. in State aid, which sum will enable the City of Cambridge to provide better educational opportunities for the students in the Cambridge School System and increase the level of public services available to the citizens of Cambridge, as a result of the efforts of Representative Peter Vellucci, in cooperation with the legislative leadership and Governor Michael S. Dukakis; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record congratulating Representative Peter Vellucci for his efforts on behalf of the citizens of Cambridge for this great legislative victory; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is directed to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to him, to record our appreciation for this legislative triumph.
