- WHEREAS: This City Council was saddened upon learning of the death of Marion Valentino, a long-time resident of Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Marion was a devoted wife and mother to her nine children, five of whom were born with myotonic dystrophy, a form of muscular dystrophy, a disease which requires much care and attention on a daily basis; and
- WHEREAS: Marion always provided help and assistance to friends and neighbors, regardless of her own personal or family concerns, an attribute not often found in today's "non-descript" world where everything has to be done in a hurry without thought or consideration; and
- WHEREAS: Marion, who herself suffered from chronic heart disease assisted her children in finding homes and jobs, a position she was well qualified for from the days of her service as a member of the Cambridge Housing Authority Tenant Council; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our deepest sympathy to Americo Valentino and his children at this time of deep personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Valentino Family on behalf of the entire City Council.
