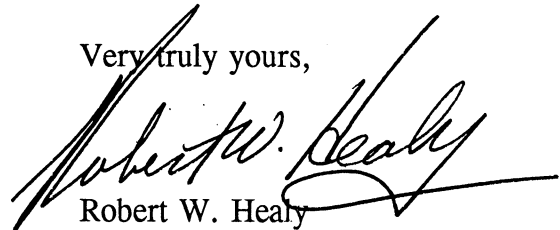

To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the transfer of \$29,000.00 from the Fire Department Salary & Wages Account to the Fire Department Extraordinary Expenditure Account to provide funds for the purchase of four defibrillator's to be issued to the following companies, Engine Company #2 Lafayette Square, Engine Company #3 East Cambridge, Engine Company #4 Porter Square, and Engine Company #9 Lexington Avenue. The equipment is used to restore cardiac activity in cases of sever heart attack. The funds will also be used for the purchase of a Posi-Chek Unit for re-calibration of all breathing apparatus as required by numerous regulatory agencies. The remaining funds will be used to purchase a cellular fax-phone unit for the new special operations unit. This will allow hazardous material information to be sent directly to the scene.
