

To the Honorable Committee of Finance

Gentlemen

I desire to call your special attention to the
pressing need of citizens from Village street and
vicinity getting out from State street to Main through
the wet weather during this fall and winter. They
formerly crossed lots (it is now objected to by the owners
of said lots) I have paid this year into the City Treasury
over five hundred dollars, and have created more
taxable property by eight tenements on State street
which are now ready to rent, and I am prevented for
the reason asked for. If Union is opened there is no special
need of doing anything to it at present except putting
in a few loads of ashes and ^{slut} scraping. I will move the
building and clear the gravel for \$250, and will also
build a plank sidewalk from State to Main streets
four feet wide at my own expense. - I hope you
will provide some way to have it opened at once
