Dear Mr. Healy:

I have reviewed the plans for the proposed driveways at No. 6 Standish Street and Nos. 373 and 375 Huron Avenue and also the decision of the Board of Zoning Appeals.

It is my recommendation that these driveways be approved with the following conditions:

1. That the Standish Street driveway be an "ENTRANCE ONLY" and be signed accordingly and that a guard be stationed there during school hours to assist any children who walk down this street to and from school.
2. That the Huron Avenue driveway be an "EXIT ONLY" and be signed accordingly. The Traffic and Parking Department will promulgate the necessary regulation for the "RIGHT TURN ONLY" and "STOP" signs out of this driveway.

Although a special permit was issued by the Board of Zoning Appeals, I would suggest that this parking area be locked and some sort of barrier be installed to protect the abutters from undue noise and pollution from motor vehicles starting and stopping.
