In Board of Aldermen, April 20. 1850.-

~~Ordered~~ Resolved, That the Public convenience and necessity require that Prescott Street, or Charles Street, as it is sometimes called, between Harvard Street and Broadway, should be laid out as a public highway.-

Ordered, That said street be and the same is hereby laid out and established as a public highway, by metes and bounds as follows; Beginning at the Northern corner of land of ^{Mrs. Alexander C. Becket} ~~Essex~~ ^{St. Hastings}, at a stone post on Broadway, and thence extending South Westerly in a straight line to a point in the line of Harvard Street, distant five and a half inches South Easterly from the North Westerly face of the stone post standing at the South Westerly corner of land of James S. Green: the said street to be forty feet in width through its whole extent, and to lie wholly on the North Westerly side of the before described line: the said street being delineated on a Plan drawn by Alex. Wadsworth, Surveyor, and this day adopted by this Board.

Ordered, That said street be hereafter called Prescott Street.

and that the Superintendent of Streets cause sign-boards to
be erected on said street, bearing that name.
