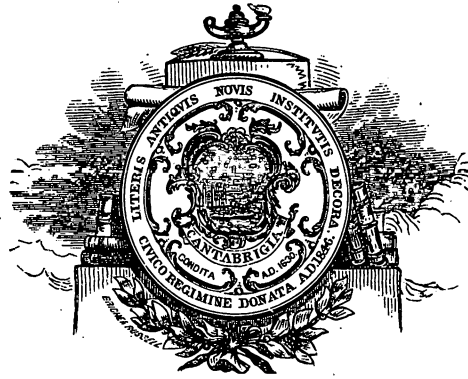


CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.



In Board of Aldermen, *March 25, 1874.*

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that

Main Street
be widened on its southerly side,

by taking for this purpose certain parcels of land, as shown on a plan prepared by the City Engineer, and now before this Board.

Therefore, Ordered, that so much of the land on *the southerly side of*
Main Street
between Brookline and Mount Streets,

as is included between the — lines shown on a plan of *Part of Main*
Street, drawn by the City Engineer, dated *March 9, 1874.* and now before this
Board, be taken for public use, and laid out as a public way and a part of said *Main*
— Street.

Ordered, That damages occasioned by said *widening* be estimated
and awarded as follows:
