IN CITY COUNCIL

September 29, 1980

ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to T.T. the Bear's Place for the erection of a sign at 10 Brookline Street, Cambridge, MA.

Provided that, before erecting the above named sign, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said sign.

Dear Mr. Healy:

We received your letter dated
September 9, 1900.

We had considered during construction
of our restaurant a sign such as has
been requested. We felt at that
time, the number of advertising signs
over the public way along that stretch
of Brookline Street, between Mass.
avenue and Green Street, would make
a flat sign of the nature and taste
that we would construct, totally
obscure and defeat the purpose of a
business sign.

We felt that once the proposition
was partially built, enclosing it in
a tasteful manner and mounting
a small sign on that proposition
would serve the purpose of
providing notice without causing
undue hazards.

T.T. The Bear's Place did not, at
any time consider the use of neon, flashing
lights, garish color or any of the
other sign types which would attract

the necessary attention needed if
our sign did not appear. Central
Square has enough of this type of
"Broadway signs"

It is our honest feeling that we
have done the best that we could under
the circumstances to attract attention
to our business, without creating an
offensive atmosphere in our corner
of Central Square. We feel that our
Design is attractive, the projection
slight enough not to cause hazards
or interfere with fire fighting and
is small by comparison to the other
signs on our street.

We have tried in the past we have
been in Cambridge to work with all
departments and officials in the city
and it is our hope that our request
for this permit will be granted.

Thank you for your consideration
in this matter and our sincere
apologies for not writing immediately
but with opening this week we have
at times been overwhelmed with work.
