Subject City Council Order #19 of September 12, 1988 concerning Riverside Road.

We have checked the location of the survey points and layout of Riverside Road. This road has a 40' Right of Way that runs from Magazine Street to Memorial Drive through the parking lot of the Stop and Shop parking area. We have installed street name signs at both ends and have also painted crosswalks and stop lines at both the intersection of Memorial Drive and Magazine Street.

It is our proposal to paint edge lines, center and arrows this Spring. The reason for waiting until the Spring is that we need an official layout of the street and any paint put down in this lot will not last through the first snow storm as many vehicles criss-cross this street in all directions.
