- WHEREAS: Saturday, April 28, 1990 was Arbor Day; and
- WHEREAS: The Massachusetts Arborists Association organized their celebration of this occasion by donating a program of tree service at Kingsley Park at the Fresh Pond Reservation; and
- WHEREAS: This service involved using \$3 million worth of equipment, \$60,000 worth of labor and material and the participation of over 30 companies to do pruning, tree removal and planting; and
- WHEREAS: Four companies, Homestead Tree Company, Shemin Nursery, Gold Star Nursery and Nursery Services donated two red oaks and four sugar maples; and
- WHEREAS: The Massachusetts Arborists Association each year make a similar contribution at this time to a Massachusetts community; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council hereby records its special thanks to the Massachusetts Arborists Association for this gift of time, talent and resources; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council particularly recognizes and commends President Kenneth Greeno; Director and Chair of the 1990 Arbor Project, Jack Kelly (City of Cambridge arborist); and Executive Director Virginia Wood for their leadership in this effort.
