Ordered, Whereas:

An advertisement appeared in the Cambridge Press under the heading "Notice to Contractors - Proposal for Teaming," which calls for the removal of the present paving blocks on Cambridge Street etc..

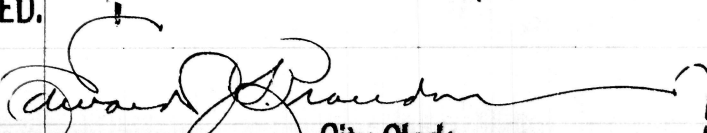
Whereas: Said Removal includes not only the teaming of the blocks but the labor of barring out the same.

Be It Resolved:

That the Board of Aldermen disapprove of this radical departure from the long established policy of the Street department. We consider it a violation of the Principle of Sect 7 of the Revised Ordinances. "Sentinel and Salaries"
"No person who is not a resident of Cambridge shall be employed as a laborer in any department of the city: and in the employment of laborers in any department of the city, preference shall be given to efficient and steady men who have families or minor children dependent upon them for support."
