- WHEREAS: It has been brought to the attention of this City Council that a Testimonial Dinner honoring Dr. Antonio Augusto Carvalho de Faria, Counsul General of Portugal in Boston, will be held on Friday, June 2, 1978; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Carvalho de Faria was born on October 24, 1935 at Barcelos, in the Province of Minho, Portugal; and
- WHEREAS: After graduating from the University of Lisbon he served as an Officer in the Infantry Regiment of the Portuguese Army, with service in Angola, and after which he became a member of the Diplomatic Corps, serving in various posts, including the Embassy of Portugal in Kinshasa, Zaire; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Carvalho de Faria was transferred to Boston as Consul General of Portugal on September 25, 1974, and in this office he quickly made friends with representatives of the various Portuguese communities, serving not only the Portuguese government but also the immigrant and Portuguese-American communities by involving himself in all their activities; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Carvalho de Faria will be leaving Boston the end of July for a new post at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Lisbon, Portugal; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council go on record as being in appreciation of Dr. Carvalho de Faria's career of distinguished service and extending our best wishes to him as he assumes his new responsibilities; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation to Dr. Carvalho de Faria.
