WHEREAS: John Shattuck, formerly the Vice President of Government, Community and Public Affairs at Harvard University, has been named by President Clinton to the position of Assistant Secretary of State for Democracy, Human Rights and Labor and the United States Senate has now confirmed his appointment; and

WHEREAS: John Shattuck had a distinguished career in civil rights, prior to coming to Harvard, as Executive Director of the American Civil Liberties Union, even a card-carrying member, has been the recipient of many awards; and

WHEREAS: In his strong support of John Shattuck in the confirmation hearing before the Senate, our own Senator Ted Kennedy said, "Dictators and tyrants know the name of John Shattuck;" and

WHEREAS: John Shattuck served with distinction as Vice President at Harvard, providing a meaningful link to the Cambridge community and becoming a strong supporter of the public schools and other Cambridge-based activities; and

WHEREAS: During John's tenure at Harvard, relationships between the University and the City grew more harmonious notwithstanding the fact that each has needs and agendas that frequently are mismatched; and

WHEREAS: Now that he will function at the highest levels of diplomacy, having had good practice in town/gown relations, John Shattuck may even be able to return to provide more objective counseling to Harvard and Cambridge in conciliation through the art of blue smoke and mirrors; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council hereby wishes John Shattuck all the best for his new role in representing our country in the critical issues of civil and human rights and congratulates President Clinton for his wisdom in appointing John Shattuck; and be it further

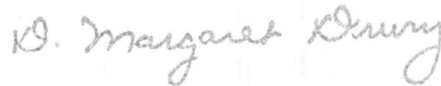
RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to John Shattuck on behalf of the entire City Council.
