standing, agreeably, to the rules and regulations of the Constitution, and the laws of this Commonwealth.

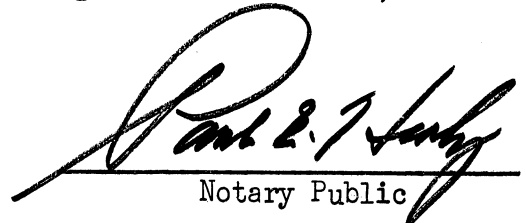

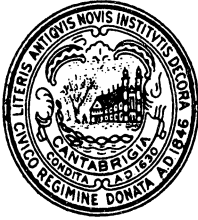

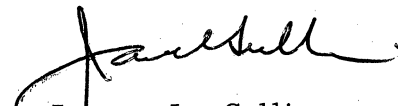
To the Honorable, the City Council:
