ORDERED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is authorized and instructed to notify and warn such of the inhabitants of the City of Cambridge as are qualified by law to vote for candidates at the Municipal Election on Tuesday, November 6, 1979 to assemble at the voting places designated by the Election Commission, then and there to give in their votes for nine members of the City Council and six members of the School Committee and also to give in their "yes" or "no" answer to the six questions which appear on the official ballot as prepared by the Secretary of State; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Clerk be instructed to give notice that the polls will be open from eight o'clock A. M. on said date until eight o'clock P. M. on said date.

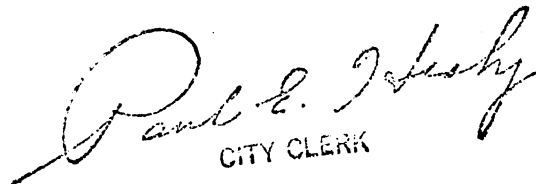
