- WHEREAS: Senior citizens are declared "of age" for most purposes, such as retirement benefits and for merchandising discounts; and
- WHEREAS: Most "seniors" living on fixed incomes have little enough money to spend on recreation; and
- WHEREAS: The Municipal Golf Course is a great source of recreation to many of the City's seniors; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to consider reducing the age qualification for seniors from 65 to 62 for the golf course fees; said reduction to be for Cambridge residents.
