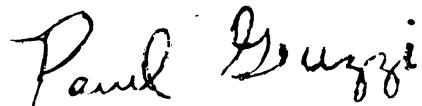

To cooperate with other organizations and associations having common interests in the travel industry.

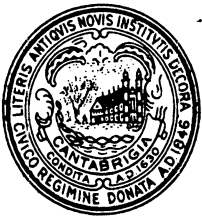
To collect, compile and publish informations of general interest to the travel industry for and about Africa.

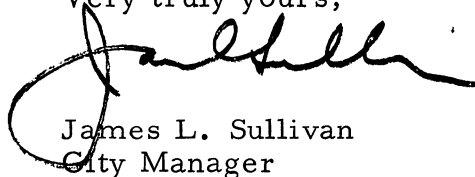
