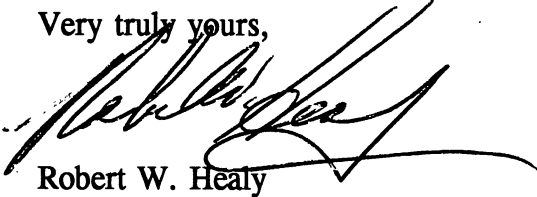

To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$10,000.00 in the Grant Fund from Cudaback Strategic Communications \$5,000.00 and Stride-Rite Corporation \$5,000.00 to the Human Services Department Other Ordinary Maintenance Account.

Under the leadership of former Mayor Alice Wolf these grants were generated to assist the Kid's Council in planning for the implementation of it's School Based Center for Families. The Center is the Kid's Councils' first initiative and will entail the development of a network of services providing family support and strengthening the link between schools and communities. Center staff will work collaboratively with school personnel and local service providers to give prevention, early intervention and crisis management services to all families - both on site and through referrals. The Center will forge links between families, schools, city government and other ancillary services on behalf of Cambridge families and children.
