WHEREAS:

The City Council has received notice of the death on July 4th of John P. Good, a former member and president during the year 1918. In recognition of the public service rendered by the deceased, it is
RESOLVED:

That the City Council of Cambridge hereby records its appreciation of the valuable service given to the city and state in the various positions which from time to time he was called upon to fill.

He was born in Cambridge in the year 1876 and lived here during his entire life-time. In 1913 and 1914 he was a member of the Board of Aldermen. From 1918 to 1922 he served in the City Council and in the year 1918 was chosen to preside over that body. He was a representative to the General Court in 1914 and served as a member of the Constitutional Convention during 1917 and 1918.

To all of the duties incumbent upon these various positions he gave an earnest painstaking attention, always with a conscientious regard for the public interest. In view of his many years of faithful public service the City Council hereby offers this tribute to his memory and, it is further

RESOLVED:

That a copy of these resolutions be spread upon the records of the City Council for the year 1925.
