The Cambridge City Council voted on October 29, 1984 for the creation of a "Blue Ribbon Committee" consisting of Councillors Alfred Vellucci, Alice Wolf, Daniel Clinton, and Saundra Graham, to confer with the President of Harvard University regarding the proposed use of Craigie Arms apartment building at Mt. Auburn Street in Cambridge.

I (we) are requesting a meeting with you and your college officials regarding this matter as soon as possible.

The use of Craigie Arms is of great concern to the City Council and to the people of Cambridge. Dialogue between City officials and College officials regarding "housing for people" is essential. I (we) hope that you will "sit down" with us and discuss the very important matter of providing housing for the homeless and houseless. 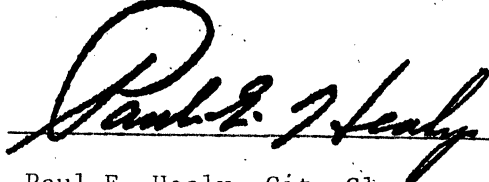
