WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of the Cambridge City Council that the Board of Directors of Cambridge Community Television (CCTV) has selected Councillor Kenneth E. Reeves, Chair of the Economic Development, Training and Employment Committee, and the members of the committee, Councillor E. Denise Simmons and Councillor Timothy J. Toomey, Jr. to receive the 2005 Joseph Sakey Award; and

WHEREAS: This award is given annually to the individuals or organizations that have made extraordinary contributions to developing access to media in Cambridge. The Sakey Award is named after the Director of the Cambridge Public Library who spearheaded the initial cable licensing in Cambridge in the early 1980's. Cambridge Community Television was established as a result of Sakey's efforts and vision, and has grown to become one of the most diverse and dynamic public access television stations in the country; and

WHEREAS: Councillor Reeves and the members of the Economic Development, Training and Employment Committee were chosen to receive the Sakey Award because of the strong support of Councillor Reeves and the committee for CCTV to provide a satellite to uplink to the award-winning *Democracy Now!* alternative news program during the Democratic National Convention in July, 2004. During this time three hours daily of Cambridge-originated programming was seen on hundreds of television stations across North America; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record extending congratulations to Councillor Kenneth E. Reeves and the Economic Development, Training and Employment Committee for being the recipients of the Joseph Sakey Award for 2005; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Councillor Kenneth E. Reeves and the Economic Development, Training and Employment Committee on behalf of the entire City Council.
