The Department of Public Utilities is proposing to amend its procedural rule 220 C.M.R. 35.08 which governs the transfer of certificates of public convenience and necessity ("Certificates") of radio common carriers ("RCC"s). The proposed amendment of the rule is intended to expedite the process of completing RCC transfers by eliminating the existing requirement of a public hearing for the approval of all RCC transfers, and replace this procedure with a notice and filing requirement coupled with Department discretion to open an investigation and hold a hearing if circumstances require it.

The above investigation is officially captioned:

Investigation of the Department on its own motion regarding the amendment of the present regulation 220 C.M.R. 35.08 which relate to transfer of certificates of public convenience and necessity for radio common carriers.

The Department of Public Utilities will conduct a public hearing on the above matter at its office, #1210 Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge, Boston, Massachusetts on Friday, January 26, 1990 at 10:00 a.m.
