- WHEREAS: Cambridge Camping Association, Inc., has proven that camping is not only for summer but for every season of the year; and
- WHEREAS: The positive impact of a stay at camp is seen not only in the fact that children feel good about themselves, but also learn to be good within themselves and to interact with children of different backgrounds; and
- WHEREAS: In addition to its work with various agencies, Cambridge Camping Association operates the Inner City Day Camp which, since 1969, has offered 800 two-week camping slots each summer to children from every neighborhood at an affordable fee. On a year-round basis, through Inner City Day Camp-Saturday, on hundred children are given recreation, education and week-end day care; and
- WHEREAS: As a vital part in the growth and development of our Cambridge community, during 1988: 1500 Cambridge children received services from Cambridge Camping Association; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That I, Alfred E. Vellucci, Mayor of the City of Cambridge, do hereby proclaim the week of April 16-23, 1989, CAMBRIDGE CAMPING ASSOCIATION WEEK in Cambridge, and urge all citizens of Cambridge to recognize the many achievements of the Cambridge Camping Association, Inc., and to give whatever support is possible so that the good work of the past will be able to continue in the present and in the future; and be it further
