IN CITY COUNCIL

October 16, 1989

ORDERED: That the previously adopted order of June 15, 1987 granting permission to Alan Savenor, doing business as, Savenor's to place cafe tables and chairs on the sidewalk at the premises numbered 92 Kirkland Street; be and hereby is amended as follows:

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Commissioner of Public Works to grant a permit to Alan Savenor, doing business as, Savenor's, pursuant to the provisions of Section 17-10 of the General Ordinances to place six 24-inch round cafe tables and eighteen chairs in front of the display widows of Savenor's located at 92 Kirkland Street during the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 8:30 p. m. Monday through Saturday and from Noon on Sundays through 6:00 p.m.; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Commissioner of Public Works to require the petitioner to post a bond in an amount sufficient to cover any claims against the City arising out of the conduct of this business and to specify any conditions or restrictions which he deems necessary to protect the safe passage and safety of the public in this area and further, ensure that the license shall conform to all statutes and ordinances of the City of Cambridge now in effect; and shall have the right to revoke said permit is he deems that any violation of this order exists.

Ladies and Gentlemen;

Please consider this petition from Savenor's Market for permission to increase the number of 24-inch round cafe tables and chairs that we put out on the sidewalk directly in front of our store at 92 Kirkland Street, from two tables and four chairs, to six tables and 18 chairs. We have found them to be very popular as a neighborhood amenity, and frankly, additional seating increases the attractiveness of our building, which translates into more customers and sales!

You may be aware that we renovated the store over the summer. As a part of the renovation we did three things that made it possible to accommodate the additional set-ups without taking up any more space on the sidewalk than we have been taking up with the assortment of things we were keeping out in front of the store prior to the renovation.

1. We arranged the layout of the store so that we could keep our shopping carts inside, instead of lined up outside on the sidewalk.

2. We removed half of the length of the bicycle rack that we had installed on the sidewalk with the permission of the public works department.

3. We found smaller, less bulky chairs that allow us to put three chairs around each table in the same space that the two chairs used to take up.

Given these adjustments in the use of the space on the sidewalk, we respectfully request that the wise members of the city council grant us the permission to increase our seating, as requested.

We would like to have them out every day in fair weather to provide seating both for the few people who may buy snacks at our store, as well as to provide a neighborhood amenity for those who might like to relax or meet on our block.
