Gentlemen:

Today a resident of Worcester Street, Cambridge was viciously attacked and bitten by one of three savage dogs who belong at 18 Worcester Street and who are often at large on this street. Mrs. Muriel Gilbert of 11 Worcester Street was attacked and so savagely bitten by one of these dogs as she was returning from church about noon today that she required immediate emergency treatment at Cambridge City Hospital, and the outcome of this attack is not yet known.

The Cambridge Police Department has been notified a number of times about the danger to neighbors of attack from these dogs over a period reaching back to last fall. To our knowledge no action has been taken.

At this time, we the neighbors on Worcester Street demand the immediate destruction of these dogs as they remain and continue a threat to the men, women and especially the children on this street.

We, the undersigned, hereby demand that you take immediate action to have these dogs destroyed and prevented from committing further nuisance and annoyance and harm to the neighbors of this street.
