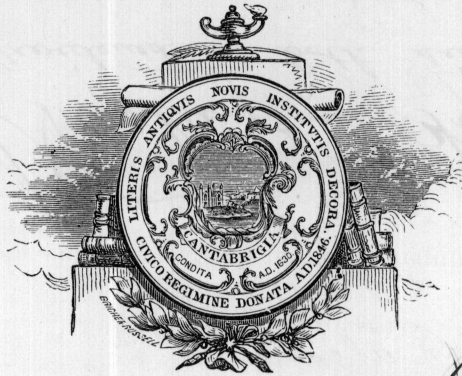


CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.



In Board of Aldermen, *June 26, 1872*

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that

Washington Street
be widened on both sides thereof

by taking for this purpose certain parcels of land, as shown on a plan prepared by the City Engineer, and now before this Board.

Therefore, Ordered, that so much of the land on *both sides of*

Washington Street

as is included between the *red* lines shown on a plan of *Washington*
on plan for Washington St. District Improvement,
Street, drawn by the City Engineer, dated *June 1870* and now before this
Board, be taken for public use, and laid out as a public way and a part of said *Wash-*
ington Street.
