To the Honorable, the City Council:


I have Oliver Brooks' communication forwarded to me by Mr. Paul Healy, City Clerk, requesting that Fresh Pond and the Golf Course be made available from sunrise to sunset.

I should like to advise your Honorable Body that I have discussed this matter with Paul G. Cowles, Superintendent of Recreation Department, and William McGinness, Superintendent of the Water Department. Mr. McGinness advises me that the reservation is generally open during the requested period ~~excepting for the parking lot at the foot of Kingsley Park.~~ He further advises me that he exercises modest security requirements on this particular area in keeping with a requirement of the United States Corps of Engineers who apparently have security concerns on domestic water supply facilities.

Mr. Cowles advises me that he has received no requests from any of the golfers to open the course earlier in the morning. I have suggested to Mr. Cowles that he confer with some of the regular morning golfers to ascertain whether an earlier opening hour might be desired. He indicated to me if this were to prove to be necessary he would take the necessary steps to have this accomplished.

I trust this information will satisfy your Honorable Body on this particular matter.
