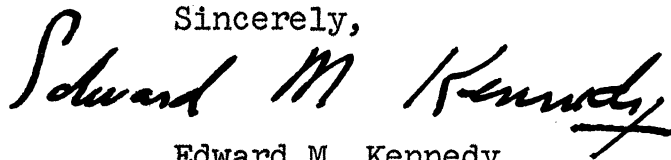
Dear Mr. Sullivan:

Thank you for your recent correspondence urging an increase in appropriations for Urban Renewal.

During consideration of H.R. 12307 on the Senate floor yesterday, I supported and voted for an amendment which would have increased the appropriation for Urban Renewal to \$873 million, or a total of \$1587 million including previous appropriations. Unfortunately, this amendment was defeated, and the figure in the Senate bill remains at \$250 million, which is an increase of \$150 million over the amount approved by the House.

I want to thank you again for giving me your views on this matter. I agree with you completely that this is a matter of great concern in our cities, and I regret that a greater amount could not be appropriated.

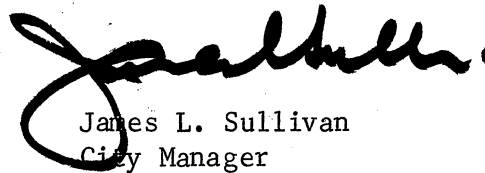
