In reply to your order of April 16TH. INST. relative to the nuisance at the corner of Cambridge and Baldwin Sts, I beg to inform you that for over one year this department has not received any complaint about conditions at that corner.


I have communicated with Mr. Alfred Bertelli, the Boston Manager of the Harvard Brewing Co, and he informed me that he had received complaints from some of the neighbors relative to the noise made by trucks owned and operated by the Sheridan Bros, Inc. a trucking concern that occupies part of their building at number 14 Baldwin St, which is directly in the rear of 1161 Cambridge Street.

As a result of the complaints his company has served a notice on the Sheridan Bros. Inc. to vacate the premises as they did not want any complaints registered against the Brewing Company.

Mr. Bertelli has furnished me with a copy of the notice which he caused to be served on the trucking company and he also has assured me that he will rid the premises of any nuisance which is offensive to the neighborhood.

I am enclosing a copy of the notice to vacate.

Gentlemen:

In compliance with your request, we submit the following:

No complaints have ever been made to this Board relative to any alleged nuisances on Baldwin Street near Cambridge Street.

The history of the case, however, is as follows:

A license for a six car garage and 550 gallons of gasoline was granted for this location on November 24, 1924, and a license covering an unloading platform inside the building and an additional 1000 gallons of gasoline was granted on August 4, 1944.

A wholesaler's or manufacturer's liquor license was granted to the Harvard Brewing Company by the Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission on October 29, 1943, over which we have no control.



At your request, I have investigated the alleged nuisance on Baldwin Street near Cambridge Street which is used by the Sheridan Trucking Company.

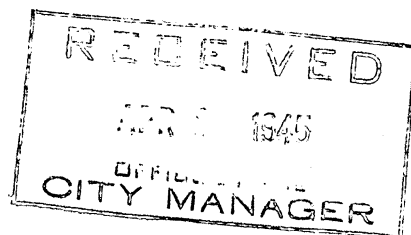
I find that their business is done from 7:30 in the morning until 6:30 at night. At that time, the last truck enters or leaves the yard. The yard is very neat and clean in my opinion and during the many times I visited the place, there was not the slightest sign of any noise or disturbance. The driveway is one that has been there for many years when the Boston Elevated Railway Company occupied the grounds and buildings.

My personal opinion is that there is no nuisance whatsoever and they were very cooperative when I went there and were open to suggestions.


