September 23, 1985

- WHEREAS: Issues related to Harvard housing and real estate have frequently divided Harvard and the community; and
- WHEREAS: Right now, there are several "hot" issues, such as the 10 Mt. Auburn development and the sale of 2 and 3 family houses; and
- WHEREAS: There is a need for the City and the University to have dialogue over a period of time to try to find solutions that are considerably more satisfactory to the community; therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That the Mayor be requested to establish a sub-committee of City Councillors to meet with representatives of Harvard; and be it further
- ORDERED: That President Bok of Harvard be requested to appoint representatives, including someone from Harvard Real Estate office for the purpose of these meetings; and be it further
- ORDERED: That a series of meetings, publicly advertised but informal, be established for the purpose of discussing Harvard housing issues; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to assign a member from the Community Development Department to assist the City Council Sub-Committee.
