ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Plant Works Florist for the erection of an awning at the premises numbered 1784-1786 Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge, Massachusetts.

Provided that, before erecting the above named awning the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Inspectional Services Department and file with the City Clerk a bond in the sum of Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) Dollars, conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the installation, maintenance and use of said awning.

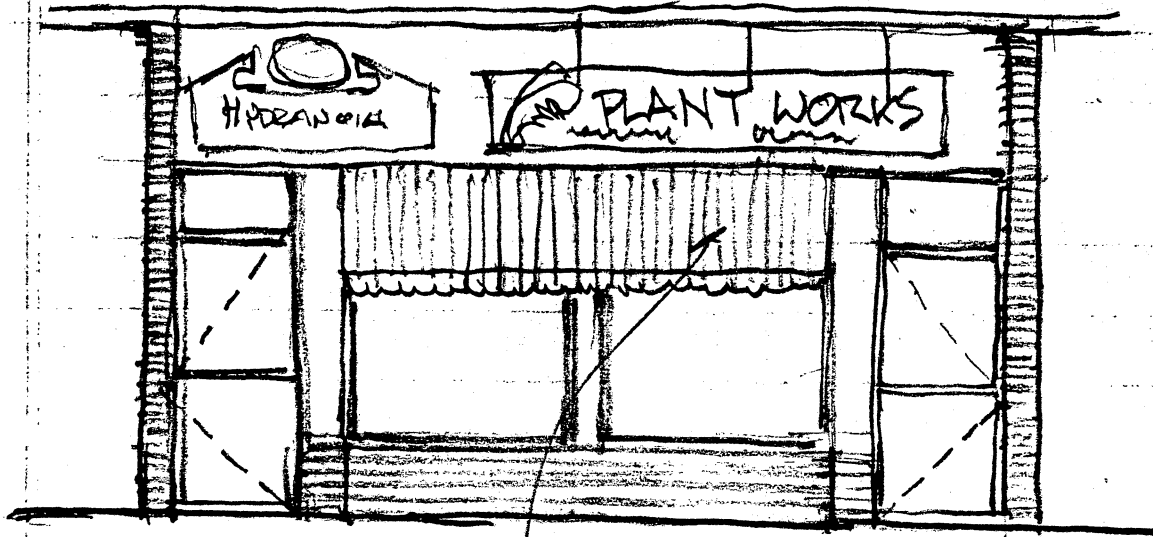

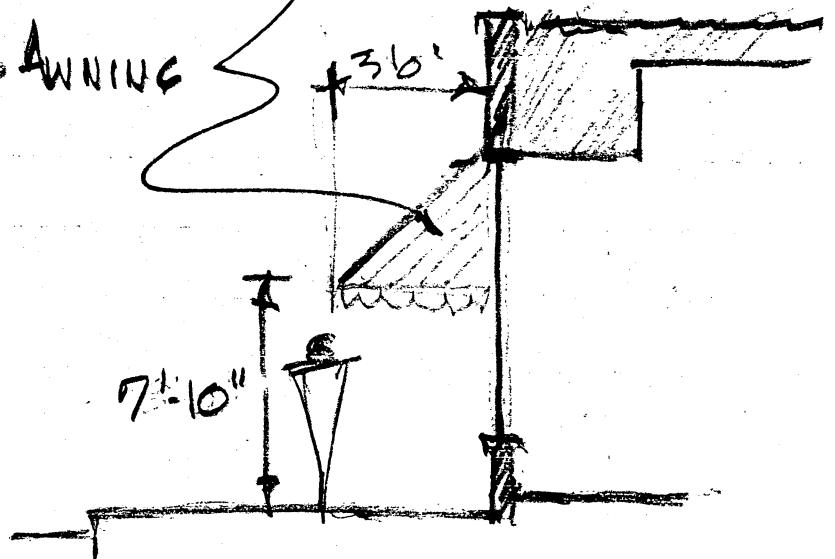
