

City of Cambridge,
in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven.

An Ordinance,
establishing the salaries of certain City Officers.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City
of Cambridge, as follows:—

1. The Officers of the City,
hereinafter named, shall receive the following annual
salaries, to be paid in equal quarterly payments,
which shall be in full for all services rendered in
their official capacity:—

City Treasurer, one hundred and fifty dollars;
City Clerk, exclusive of fees established by law,
five hundred dollars;
Clerk of the Common Council, one hundred dollars;
Board of Assessors, five hundred dollars;
Collector of Taxes, five hundred dollars;
City Messenger, two hundred dollars;
Chief Engineer, one hundred dollars;
Four Assistant Engineers, twenty-five dollars each.

2. Be it further ordained,
That an Ordinance, "establishing the salary of the
Collector of Taxes", passed June 9, 1846, also an Ordinance,
"establishing the salaries of sundry City Officers", passed
Sept. 22, 1846, be, and the same are, hereby repealed.
