- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Acheson (Mike) Callaghan, Jr., a long time Cambridge resident and Chairman of the Cambridge Rent Control Board, has resigned his position effective November 20, 1984, completing nine years of service to this unpaid Board; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Callaghan is a 1961 graduate of Harvard University and in 1964 obtained his law degree from Harvard Law School and is currently serving as a partner in the firm of Palmer and Dodge, being the second most senior partner in litigation whose area of expertise encompasses the economic regulation of and rate-setting for the insurance industry; and
- WHEREAS: While serving as a member and Chairman of the Rent Control Board since 1975, he has presided over the growth of the Board's case-load and staff and has provided tremendously important leadership through the very challenging period of the implementation of the "Removal Permit Ordinance" and has from the inception of his appointment provided key intellectual, as well as legal guidance to the Board; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere gratitude and appreciation to Attorney Acheson (Mike) Callaghan, Jr., for his years of dedicated service and for his deep level of sincerity in the job he undertook for nine years and to further wish him, his wife Gail and their two children much good health and happiness in the years ahead; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mr. Callaghan on behalf of the entire City Council.
