Saint Mary's Common Place sale was discussed. An unconfirmed rumor has it that a purchase and sales agreement has been signed by an equally unknown buyer.

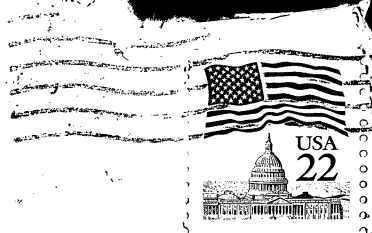

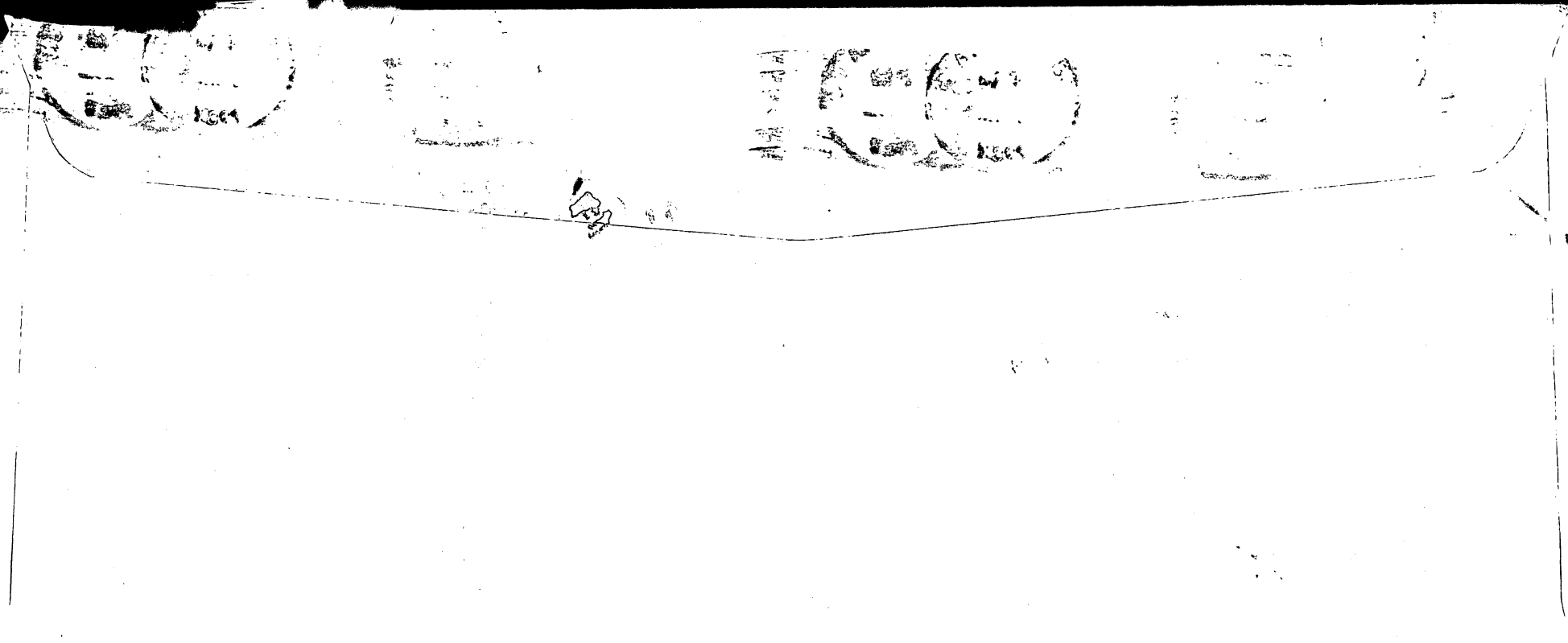
