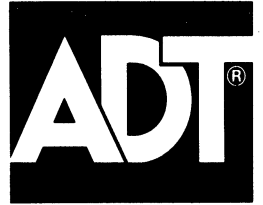

This change was made with no notice or public hearing or without any consideration of the financial impact which will accrue to my business and others.

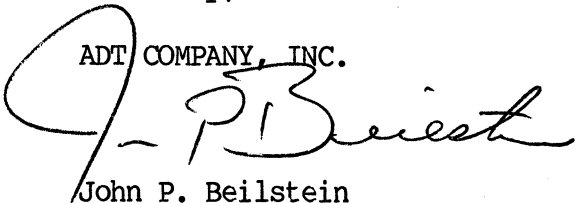
