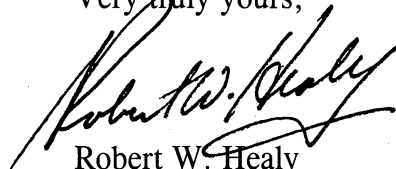
To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 99-32, regarding a report on the removal of two parking spaces on the Somerville side of Willow Streets, please be advised of the following:

The Traffic, Parking & Transportation Department has investigated the parking conditions along the eastside of Willow Street near the Somerville line. The parking restriction signs in question were installed in the late 1970's to allow access to the loading/dumpster area at the Roosevelt Towers housing complex. Due to the recent renovations to the complex, the need for accessing this area for loading/dumping has been eliminated.

The Department will shorten the "no parking" zone approximately 80 feet, which will provide an additional three to four "resident parking only" spaces.
