- WHEREAS: Public works services provided in Cambridge are an integral part of our citizens' everyday lives and are vital to the health, safety, and comfort of the community; and
- WHEREAS: The support of an understanding and informed citizenry is crucial to the efficient operation of public works systems and programs such as water, sewers, streets and highways, public buildings, solid waste collection and snow removal; and

- RESOLVED: That all citizens and civic organizations be urged to acquaint themselves with the issues involved in providing public works services and with the contributions which public works personnel make every day to our community.
