In Common Council,

March 12th 1889

ORDERED,

That the Committee on Roads & Bridges be authorized to advertise for proposals & contract for such supply of cracked Stone as may be sufficient for the needs of the Street department for three years; said Stone to be delivered at suitable intervals during the term of the contract at such times and places as may be required by the Superintendent of Streets, for the time being.

Such Stone to be paid for from time to time as delivered, under the provisions of the Ordinances in relation to contracts, and the expense thereof, so incurred, to be charged to the appropriation for Street department (Repairs).
