- WHEREAS: Hellas United displayed a tremendous team effort while compiling an outstanding record of 19-6-1, scoring 72 goals (league high) while allowing only 28 goals (second lowest in the league); and
- WHEREAS: Hellas United will be the first Cambridge team in more than a decade to represent the State of Massachusetts in the United States Professional National Cup where they will compete with the best teams from other states including teams from Major League Soccer (MLS); and
- WHEREAS: Hellas United set a new state disciplinary record of six yellow and one red card in twenty-six games and for the first time ever the second division champions defeated the first division champions; now therefore be it
