Reports, The Public Aid Committee reports, pursuant to the rules of the City Council, that it has obtained from the Secretary of the Board of Public Welfare and from the W.P.A. Sponsor monthly reports for the Month of October.

The Board of Public Welfare reports on Old Age Assistance cases, eight less than at the end of September, and on General Relief and Aid to Dependent Children eighty-five cases less than at the end of September. These classes of cases cost the City \$112,240.29, during the Month of October, an increase of \$5,693.38, due to October being a five-week month.

The Sponsor's Agent reports four hundred and fifty-one persons employed during the Month of October on W.P.A. projects, a decrease of one hundred and ninety-four from the previous month. The cost for October was \$1,405.55 to the City, a decrease of \$4,033.57 and \$27,729. to the Federal Government, a decrease of \$16,522.68. One hundred and two persons were placed in private employment by the Municipal Employment Bureau, of whom 31 were from Welfare and 40 from W.P.A.
