That the Superintendent of Streets be authorized to complete the sidewalks upon the streets hereinafter named, by setting edgestones where necessary, and by laying brick pavement thereon. The expense to be charged to the appropriation for Street Department, (Paving, Edgestones and Sidewalks). The cost of materials furnished to be assessed upon the owners of abutting estates, according to law.

On the southerly side of Gore Street, from Sixth Street to the Somerville line, where not paved, about 360 feet.

In front of No. 65 Charles Street, about 33 feet.

On the north side of Blake Street, from Hendersons block, near North Avenue to Orchard Street, about 363 feet.

On west side of Lowell Street, from Brattle Street to the southerly line of land of Helen P. Ellis.
Edgestones, about 295 feet.
Brick Sidewalk, about 440 feet.
