The licensee may neither pick-up nor drop-off passengers or goods in Cambridge under this license; and be it further

ORDERED: That this license is granted subject to the condition that Air Limo Services, Inc. of 288 Littleton Road, Westford, file with the City Clerk a schedule each year of all routes and any amendments thereto; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Council reserves the right to revoke the license granted in the event of the breach of any of the conditions outlined above.

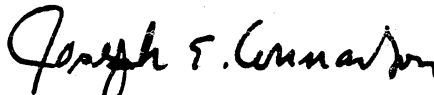

Attached please find the application of Air Limo Services which will provide a daily transportation service between their terminal in Westford and Logan International Airport. The service will not stop in Cambridge but will travel along Route 16 between the Arlington/Cambridge line and the Cambridge/Somerville line.

I have consulted with the three License Commissioners and George Teso and they do not believe that this type of service starting from and returning to the town of Westford via Route 16 and not stopping in Cambridge would be a problem. The License Commission and Traffic and Parking Department therefore recommend that you approve and transmit this application to the City Council, subject to the condition that the applicant make neither pick-ups nor drop-offs in Cambridge.

Enclosed as background documents are: (1) a letter from the applicant seeking approval; (2) a copy of the applicant's (120) day license from the D.P.U.; and (3) a proposed license to be signed.

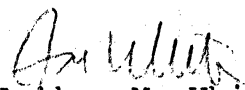
As you may be aware from prior correspondence, this office represents Air Limo Services, Inc., of 288 Littleton Road, Westford, Mass. (the Company).

The Company has recently begun regularly scheduled, daily transportation services between their terminal in Westford and Logan International Airport, with an intermediate stop in Concord. These services are being provided in accordance with the enclosed schedule and with the authority granted by the Department of Public Utilities as indicated in the enclosed decision and order. This decision has granted the ability to provide a scheduled service on a temporary basis. It is now necessary for the Company to acquire a street license pursuant to Mass. General Laws Chapter 159A Section 1 from each municipality in which the service travels. Petition of Air Limo Services, Inc., of Westford, Massachusetts, for a temporary license, pursuant to G.L. c. 159A, § 5.

On December 3, 1987, Air Limo Services, Inc. ("Petitioner"), a Massachusetts corporation with a principal place of business in Westford, Massachusetts, petitioned the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") to issue it a 120-day temporary license, pursuant to G.L. c. 159A, § 5, as amended, authorizing the operation of motor vehicles for the common carriage of passengers for hire over public ways in Westford, Littleton, Acton, Concord, Lincoln, Lexington, Arlington, Cambridge, Somerville, Medford, Everett, Chelsea and Boston.

The purpose of the proposed service is to provide regularly scheduled transportation between Westford and Logan Airport ("Logan") in Boston. The Petitioner is presently providing door-to-door, on-call limousine service to Logan. That service carries between 30 to 40 passengers a day and makes 11 round trips. The Petitioner has purchased a secure, fenced-in,

well-lighted, facility in Westford. The facility has a terminal and a parking area for 320 automobiles. The Petitioner plans to provide parking for persons using the Petitioner's proposed, regularly scheduled service to Logan.

The Petitioner's on-call limousine service costs \$23 from Westford to Logan and \$28 from Logan to Westport. The Petitioner proposes to charge \$16 each way for the service between the Petitioner's terminal and Logan.

G.L. c. 159A, § 5, as amended, provides that, in order to provide for sudden, unusual or unforeseen transportation needs, the Department may issue a 120-day temporary license as it deems that public convenience and necessity require. Section 5 also requires that a copy of the application for the 120-day temporary license be served on the affected municipalities. A certificate of service, filed with the instant petition, attests that a copy of the instant petition has been served on the 13 municipalities on the Petitioner's specified route.

The petition also states that the Petitioner has applied for the municipal street licenses required under G.L. c. 159A, § 1, as amended, and is preparing to file with the Department a petition for the certificate of public convenience and necessity ("CPCN") required under G.L. c. 159A, § 7. Because section 7 is conditioned on a petitioner being the holder of section 1 municipal street licenses, and because section 1 allows a municipality 60 days in which to act on a request for a

municipal street license, the Petitioner filed the instant petition with the Department in order to begin the service immediately.

Upon review, the Department finds that the acquisition of a terminal and parking facility to provide long term parking for persons using Logan constitutes an unusual transportation need. The Department also finds that the alleviation of parking problems at Logan, especially during holiday travel times, is in the public interest and is required by public convenience and necessity.

Accordingly, after consideration, it is

ORDERED: That the petition of Air Limo Services, Inc., requesting the Department of Public Utilities to issue it a 120-day temporary license, pursuant to G.L. c. 159A, § 5, as amended, beginning on the date of this Order, be and is hereby **GRANTED;** and it is

On Littleton Road (Route 110) between the Air Limo Service, Inc. terminal at 228 Littleton Road and Power Road
On Power Road between Littleton Road and the Westford/Littleton line

IN LITTLETON:

On Power Road between the Westford/Littleton line and Great Road (Route 119)
On Great Road between Power Road and the Littleton/Acton line

IN ACTON:

On Great Road between the Littleton/Acton line and Main Street

On Route 2A between Main Street and the Acton/Concord line

IN CONCORD:

On Route 2A between the Acton/Concord line and Route 2
On Route 2 between Route 2A and the Concord/Lincoln line

IN LINCOLN:

On Route 2 between the Concord/Lincoln line and the
Lincoln/Lexington line

IN LEXINGTON:

On Route 2 between the Lincoln/Lexington line and the
Lexington/Arlington line

IN ARLINGTON:

On Route 2 between the Lexington/Arlington line and the
Arlington/Cambridge line

IN CAMBRIDGE:

On Route 16 between the Arlington/Cambridge line and the
Cambridge/Somerville line

IN SOMERVILLE:

On Route 16 between the Cambridge/Somerville line and the
Somerville/Medford line

IN MEDFORD:

On Route 16 between the Somerville/Medford line and the
Medford/Everett line

IN EVERETT:

On Route 16 between the Medford/Everett line and Second Street
On Second Street between Route 16 and the Everett/Chelsea line

IN CHELSEA:

On Second Street between the Everett/Chelsea line and Park
Street

On Park Street between Second Street and Central Avenue

On Central Avenue between Park Street and Chelsea Street

On Chelsea Street between Central Avenue and the Chelsea/Boston
line at the Chelsea River

On Washington Street between Central Avenue and Pearl Street

On Pearl Street between Washington Street and Congress Street

On Congress Street between Pearl Street and Third

On Third Street between Congress Street and Ash Street

On Ash Street between Third Street and Second Street

IN BOSTON:

On Chelsea Street between the Chelsea/Boston line and the
Chelsea River and Neptune Street

On Neptune Street between Chelsea Street and the McClellan
Highway (Route 1A)

On McClellan Highway between Curtis Street and Logan Airport

On Curtis Street between McClellan Highway and Chelsea Street.

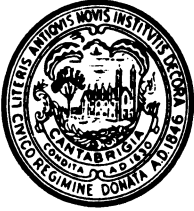

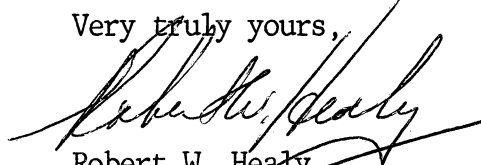
