AN ORDINANCE

In amendment to an ordinance formerly entitled "The General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge" as revised in 1972 and now designated as "The Code of the City of Cambridge".

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:

That Chapter Two entitled "Administration", Section 2-83 entitled "Competitive Contracts" is hereby amended by striking out the present section and substituting in place thereof the following new section which reads as follows:
Section 2-83. Competitive Contracts.

All purchases or contracts for purchases exceeding Two Hundred Fifty (\$250) Dollars shall be based upon competition, and all purchases or contracts for purchases of Four Thousand (\$4,000) Dollars or over shall be made in the manner provided by Article XXII of this Chapter.
